A BIT OF HISTORY

Fifty-nine years ago (June 7, 1953), Msgr Downey Council 3660 officially began operation.

On a Sunday afternoon in November 1952, Brothers Joseph Davey and Al Prestel called stating we should have a K of C Council on the southside. Additional Knights were contacted, and we met in the homes of the members. On March 5, 1953, at the home of Bro. George Rodenbaugh, 14 Catholic men gathered to discuss organizing a Southside Council of the K of C. Present were Ray Borski, Joe Davey, Leo Lauck, Leonard McGreevy, Joseph Post, Urban Renner, Larry Sanders, Carl Sanders, George Rodenbaugh, John Raftery, Bernie Stinmetz, Virgil Rohrman, William Schaefer. Bro. Joe Davey presided at the meeting. George Rodenbaugh was commissioned to seek an appointment with Archbishop Schulte regarding the founding of a Council. I was elected Chairman and subsequently became the first Grand Knight.

80 candidates received the 1st degree. The Charter members numbered 187. The first Cross & Compass was issued September, 1953 and Francis Meyers, Jr. was the Editor.

Our Council meetings were held at the Lake Shore Country Club, thanks to the kindness and hospitality of Bro. Louis Annee, until our Council home was opened in April, 1958.
