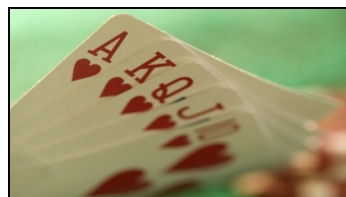
Due to the increase in the cost of liquor we will be increasing the bar prices effective May 1st. The new prices will be posted in the club room.


