There will be another letter coming soon on what the Council needs to have done.

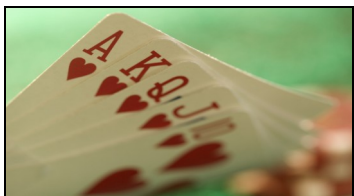
