FINANCIAL SECRETARY REPORT

Brother Knights - Earlier this year I discussed the membership breakdown of the Council and noted that we had over 350 Honorary Life Members. This class of membership is determined by the age of the member and his length of service, namely a member who has 25 years or more of consecutive service is 70 years or older. No dues are assessed to this class of members as dictated by the Supreme Council.

In discussion with the Council Officers, I suggested that we ask these members if they wished to consider giving an annual donation to Msgr. Downey Council of \$25.00 or more to help support Council Activities. These activities will not include activities of the Dining Room or the Bar. The funds will remain in the Councils account and be used for Council fraternal/social activities. Also to make donations to the Support our Seminarians (SOS) project or to purchase Gibault Raffle tickets to support the children being treated at Gibault.


