Parishioners participating in the pilgrimage are encouraged to **celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation** either 20 days prior to or 20 days after **Sunday, October 9**, and to **mediate on God's mercy after receiving Holy Communion** at the Eucharist that weekend.

In this way the requirements for the **plenary indulgence** afforded those who make the pilgrimage will be satisfied.

During the Jubilee Year of Mercy our Holy Father, Francis, has extended a **plenary indulgence** to those who **sincerely seek the mercy of God** through a **visit a pilgrimage church**. Archbishop Tobin has designated the **Cathedral Church of Saints Peter and Paul in Indianapolis** as a pilgrimage church..

The Cathedral has a **Holy Door** or a '**Door of Mercy**' through which pilgrims are invited to pass through and so enter into the **mercy of God**. An **indulgence** is the **remission** before God of the **temporal punishment** that is due to our sin. The sins that are confessed in the **Sacrament of Reconciliation**, and of which we sincerely repent, **are forgiven by God**. The **damage caused by sin**, however, **remains** and we must strive to **repair that damage** as part of our **sincere repentance**.
