

- Passing through the Door of Mercy at the Cathedral
- A Profession of Faith
- A Prayer for Pope Francis and his intentions

Parishioners participating in the pilgrimage are encouraged to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation either 20 days prior to or 20 days after Sunday, October 9, and to mediate on God's mercy after receiving Holy Communion at the Eucharist that weekend.

In this way the requirements for the plenary indulgence afforded those who make the pilgrimage will be satisfied.

During the Jubilee Year of Mercy our Holy Father, Francis, has extended a plenary indulgence to those who sincerely seek the mercy of God through a visit a pilgrimage church. Archbishop Tobin has designated the Cathedral Church of Saints Peter and Paul in Indianapolis as a pilgrimage church.. The Cathedral has a Holy Door or a 'Door of Mercy' through which pilgrims are invited to pass through and so enter into the mercy of God. An indulgence is the remission before God of the temporal punishment that is due to our sin. The sins that are confessed in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and of which we sincerely repent, are forgiven by God. The damage caused by sin, however, remains and we must strive to repair that damage as part of our sincere repentance.
