## What is Gibault?

Gibault is a place for young people to receive help and treatment. We are not a detention facility or a place for 'bad kids.' Gibault helps children whose traumatic experiences have caused them great emotional pain find hope and feel safe.

### Who Does Gibault Serve?

We serve children and youth between the ages of 6-21. Most children who come to Gibault have experienced complex trauma. Trauma is a wide range of events and challenges in a young person's life which can include physical and sexual abuse, verbal and emotional abuse, as well as neglect. Many of our children have witnessed intense domestic violence, have a care giver who is incarcerated, and have unstable home environments. Trauma affects children regardless of age, race, gender or other factors.

Many of the children in our care have experienced multiple types of trauma occurring over long periods of time. This trauma has devastating effects on children and leads to behavioral problems, difficulty trusting others and difficulty maintaining relationships as well as drug and alcohol abuse. Sadly, the list of problems that come with trauma go on and on.

## What is our Goal?

When children come to Gibault they meet with a therapist and our on-site psychologist to complete clinical assessments and identify their specific needs. These assessments make up individualized treatment plans unique to the child. Gibault uses evidence based programs and treatment options when working with each child.

The goal of these individualized programs and services is a life-changing opportunity; a chance for our kids to make their own lives better and look to a positive future where they can become happy, healthy and productive adults.




