DID YOU KNOW:

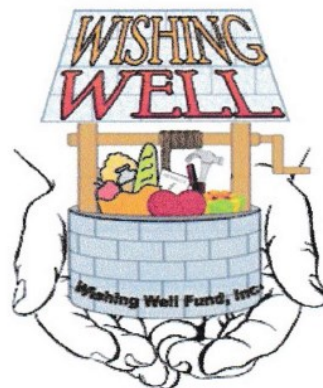
- ◇ We help over 150 families each year with food for Christmas.
