Foster Care Donation Tax Credit

If you are considering an end-of-the-year donation or you have already made a donation to Gibault, we have great news for you. Your donation may be eligible for a tax credit on your Indiana tax return. The maximum amount of credit that will be granted is 50% of the donation up to



\$10,000 for all donations to one or multiple approved foster care organizations during any one calendar year. The tax credit approval is on a first-in, first-out basis.Complete the Foster Care Donation Application and submit to the Indiana Department of Revenue, along with proof of the donation. The application can be found on our website.
