children, staff had fun scaring the kids and the kids seemed to enjoy being spooked.



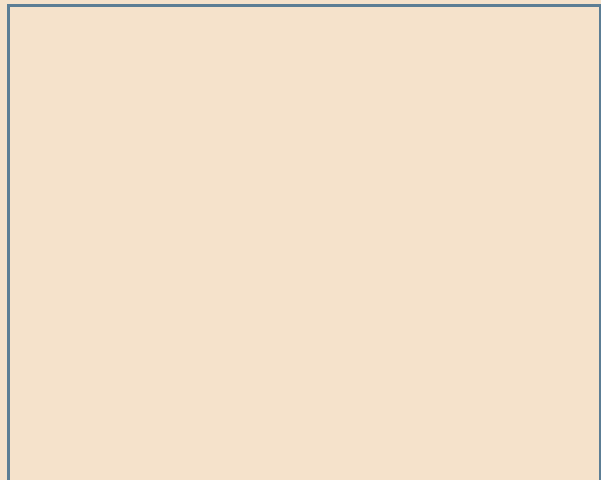
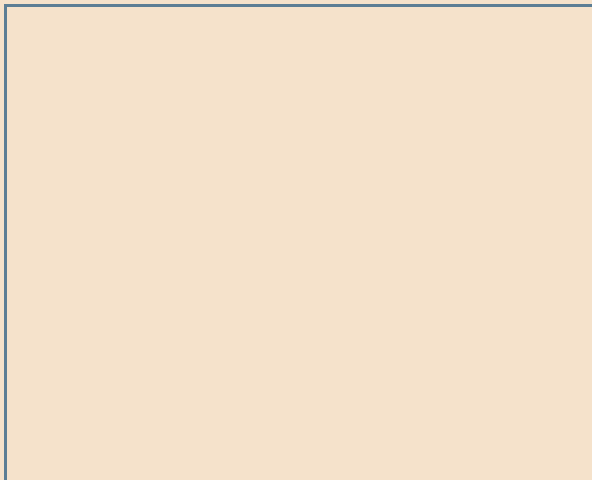

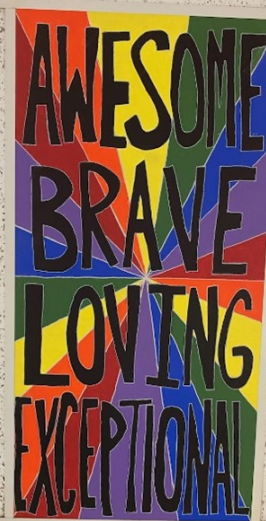
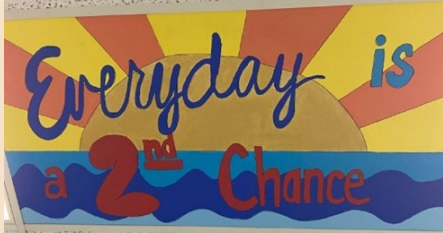
The residents, staff, and staff children got in on the fun and had a wonderful Halloween celebration with great food and costumes.
