



## Gibault in Action

Rob Sturm, COO, presented testimony to the Senate Committee in support of SB 169 on January 29th. The bill impacts residential treatment facilities twofold. It provides parity in the employment requirements for case managers. The bill also allows for Advanced Practice Registered Nurses to provide physicals and prescribe psychotropic medications. This is advantageous to facilities as modern practices, especially in Vigo and Lake Counties, employ many more of these professionals than physicians.

Several staff members and children attended the legislative foster care day in Indianapolis on February 16<sup>th</sup>. They were able to see government in action, as well as ask questions of Speaker Houston.

Michele Madley, CEO, attended the IARCA/legislative dinner on February 21<sup>st</sup> in Indianapolis. Michele's representation at these events has been instrumental in making sure our children receive the best possible care.
