On July 9th, we had a special visit from three members of the Terre Haute Federal Bureau of Prisons. Todd Royer, seen in the shirt and tie below, worked at Gibault for 10 years, leaving in 2003 to start his current career at the federal prison. Josh Gard, and his service dog Alice, were a big hit with our youth. Josh supervises the Cares, Inc. program, in which federal inmates train dogs to become service and therapy dogs. Some dogs are trained to detect anxiety attacks, seizures, and symptoms of diabetes, like low sugar levels.

The kids were very well behaved and had many insightful questions for Josh to answer.

The licks and playfulness received from Alice was much needed therapy for many
of the youth in attendance.

Knights Appeal

The area of focus this year is converting the old weight room in the gym to a movie theater and redecorating the living units both on the newly acquired Campagna Campus. The projected start date of the renovation is September 2024. Both projects must be done by a commercial contractor per Gibault's insurance liabilities and background check requirements. This is an extremely large undertaking. Converting the

old weight room into a theater with new seating will cost, at a minimum, \$20,000 and redecorating the bedrooms and common areas in all four living units will cost \$60,000.
