2nd Annual Michael J. Buske Breakfast

The 2nd Annual Michael J. Buske Ivy Tech Scholarship Pancake Breakfast raised \$2,763.00 this year! That amount was placed into the Endowment Fund. The total Annual Scholarship is now at \$8,804.50, and the Endowment Fund is \$4,433.00. On May 16th, Gibault and Ruoff Mortgage will have teams play in the annual Ivy Tech Golf Scramble.

Each team has a \$1,500.00 entry fee, which \$1,000.00 will go directly to the Buske Scholarship Fund.

Mike was an employee at Gibault in the early to mid-1990's. His impact on Gibault's campus was very much appreciated by his fellow employees and children he worked with. He went on to have a long career in coaching and teaching in the public school system, in which he coached and taught at West Vigo High School when he passed away the summer before the start of the 2023/2024 school year.

Dan Dayhuff, of the local Ruoff Mortgage – Terre Haute Branch, and Gibault employee, Keith Madley, created the scholarship in 2024 to help fund a Gibault alumni to attend any Ivy Tech campus in Indiana.
